B3K and partners continue to expand the Kern County Economic Ecosystem

Planning is underway to develop the 21st Century Wall Street District to be centered in Southeast Bakersfield. Charting a new approach to inclusive economic development opportunities, the District will act as an economic engine fueling business growth and expansion to transform the neighborhood economy.

B3K and Statewide partners will unveil California's first Fusion Energy Economic Impact Study outlining how fusion hubs could generate hundreds of billions of dollars in economic impact over the next decade.

B3K is participating on the Strata Credit Union Supervisory Committee seeking to develop a 3rd CDFI to benefit our region.

B3K's Energy Advisory Council is developing a 12-month action plan to establish Kern County as a champion in advanced energy and carbon management.

- Kern Coalition Regional Plan Part 2 with partners: Building Healthy Communities, Community Action Partnership of Kern, Kern Community College District and Kern Inyo Mono Central Labor Council.
- The California Jobs First State Economic Blueprint, built on the foundation of thirteen regional plans including the Kern Coalition Regional Plan Part 2. The Blueprint is California's economic roadmap to create, attract and ensure success to good-paying jobs.
- Economic development strategies for both the City of Bakersfield and for Kern County-Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)supporting our governments to identify strategic opportunities and to secure funding.
- B3K is a partner in the development of California's first Fusion Energy Economic Impact Study managed by the San Diego EDC in partnership with BCG, General Atomics; Go-Biz, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, Livermore Lab Foundation, Mintz, ML Strategies, Tokamak Energy, and UC San Diego Fusion Engineering Institute.

Our reports don't just sit on a shelf, we collaborate for action. B3K and our ecosystem partners went to work to implement key strategies focused on expanding the economic ecosystem of B3K's industries of focus by spearheading the establishment of:

An entrepreneurial grant program from The Launch Pad at Bakersfield College and the City of Bakersfield, delivering \$2M in grants, 499 full-time jobs, and 659 startup micro-businesses served.

The B3K Defense and Aerospace Hub, expanding talent, technology, and innovation, convening 50+ stakeholders quarterly and funding 2 STEM camps, 6 interns, and 2 PhD fellows.

A VICEROY Host Site at NACCWD developing cyber skills for future military and civilian leaders of the Armed Forces and DOD. Seven active industry ecosystem working groups with 200+ stakeholders convened by B3K.

The Mojave Aerospace Accelerator Fund (MAACC) with The Griffiss Institute and Starburst granting \$400K to support 5 defense and aerospace startups.

An entrepreneurial pilot program with Bakersfield College Launchpad, investing \$25K to support 25 minorityowned small businesses.

CO.STARTERS, a 10-week incubator with Seedcore Foundation and Kern Initiative for Talent and Entrepreneurship (KITE), supporting 47 participants and creating 18 jobs.

The High Desert Tech Bridge (TechGrid), part of the NavalX network, drives innovation and defense growth, hosting 4–5 OpenLabs and 1 Distinguished Lecture each month, plus 8 TRMC Tech Talks annually.

A CSUB endowment with Valley Strong Credit Union funding rotating research fellowships on Kern County's economic growth.

New CSUB engineering programs with Antelope Valley College, expanding STEM pathways and launching a specialized aerospace engineering program.

The inaugural Unbound: Kern Capital Summit 2025, positioning Kern County as a premier investment destination by connecting capital with high-growth industries.


Tracking our regional progress towards inclusive growth and deep prosperity

A Better Bakersfield and Boundless Kern (B3K Prosperity), is strategically focused on increasing the number of Quality Jobs in our region, so that we can reduce the number of struggling families. The overarching goal is to generate 100,000 more Good and Promising Jobs in the Bakersfield-Kern region by 2030, halving the number of children in struggling families.

This dashboard will tell the story of inclusive growth in the Bakersfield-Kern region over time and help inform local leaders and stakeholders, so that we can pursue policies and investments that advance deep prosperity.

Job Growth

Jobs creation is one of the most direct measures of a region's economic vitality. Comparing the Bakersfield-Kern region's job growth over the past decade to our peer metropolitan regions demonstrates that, while jobs have increased, very little regional job growth can be attributed to our regional economic competitiveness versus baseline growth.



Wages


Deep prosperity means enabling families and workers from all backgrounds to achieve self-sufficiency and pursue upward mobility. Wages is one of the most important measures to assess this. In 2021, B3K Prosperity established a target wage of \$21.80 per hour, or \$45,344 per year, for a "Good Job." With full-time employment and employer-sponsored benefits, a worker earning \$21.80 will be able to not only meet their basic needs but also begin saving for the economic future and ascending the economic ladder.



Employment in Traded Sectors


Traded sectors are the most important driver of regional economic competitiveness.

They include businesses that sell their goods or services to customers outside of our region, bringing new money into our regional economy. Traded sector jobs create a multiplier effect that generates between three and five new locallyserving jobs.



Access to Broadband

High-speed broadband Internet access is an essential infrastructure requirement for the modern economy, affecting not only workers but also families and students. While gaps in broadband access remain in the Bakersfield-Kern region, this is a vital metric where we perform relatively well compared to some peer and other regions in the nation.



New Firm Start-Ups

Entrepreneurship is another significant factor that both drives and demonstrates a region's economic dynamism. Our goal is to see a high number of new businesses launch in traded sectors and grow, creating new Good and Promising Jobs in the Bakersfield-Kern region.
